



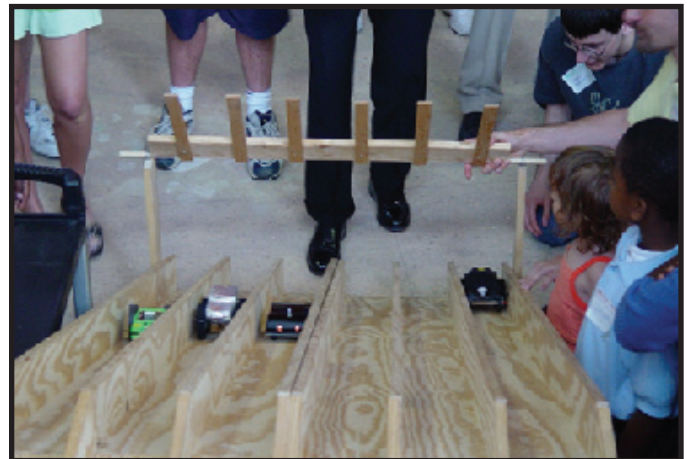
# MICRO-ELECTRIC Vehicle Competition
