The Annual SAE Detroit Section Student Exhibit Competition will take place Tuesday, April 24 in conjunction with SAE 2012 World Congress, April 24-26, at Cobo Center in Detroit, Michigan. All SAE collegiate chapters worldwide are invited to compete for cash prizes. The competition offers SAE student members the opportunity for high visibility among manufacturers, suppliers, and alumni.

Seven booth spaces have been allocated to SAE collegiate chapters to display their projects and provide visibility for chapter activities. **SAE International will provide (1) 10'x 20' booth, (1) six-foot skirted display table, (2) chairs, and (1) 110v electrical outlet.** Exhibits must be professional in appearance and incorporate the SAE 2012 World Congress theme "GetConnected." Exhibit judging will include a formal presentation by one or more team members and an informal Q&A session. Judging will start promptly at 10:00 a.m. and students must man their booths for the entire duration of the competition. The judging order will be announced the morning of the competition.

The registration deadline is **Monday, March 5, 2012** and booth space is on a first-come basis so register early!
