The Dearborn Technical Center is LINK's largest testing laboratory in the world. The 120,000 square feet facility is located in Dearborn, Michigan, and has been in operation since 2011. The test facility serves as LINK's testing technical headquarters and supports LINK test operations throughout the world.

The Dearborn Technical Center covers a wide range of testing solutions including: a Servo-hydraulic test laboratory, NVH brake dynamometers, commercial vehicle dynamometers, hub, wheel and bearing test systems, vehicle lifts for vehicle instrumentation and testing, secure vehicle storage, and a chemical testing laboratory.

The facility's laboratory space is filled with a blend of new equipment, existing assets and customer-owned equipment operated by LINK staff. The facility offers versatile testing capabilities, ranging from laboratory testing, vehicle testing, and access to various proving grounds.
