SAE Detroit Section would like to extend an invitation for local high school students to participate in the 26th Annual Micro-Electric Vehicle Competition. The competition will take place on Wednesday, May 8, 2019 at Yazaki North America, Inc. in Canton. Pizza and beverages will be provided for all students and guests. Registration will begin at 4:00 p.m., with the competition beginning promptly at 5:00 p.m.

The first objective of the competition is to design and build a dry cell powered vehicle (AA battery supplied) to race up a fixed incline while pulling a weighted trailer (supplied) to the top of a hill. The second objective is to be the first vehicle to pass the finish line with trailer in tow.

NOTE: Maximum of (6) vehicles per school can enter the competition with up to (3) students per vehicle for capacitor and non-capacitor class.

CASH PRIZE AWARDS HAVE INCREASED!

Overall – Top three schools with the highest score in both the design and performance competition will receive trophies and cash awards.

First Place \$2,000 Second Place \$1,500 Third Place \$1,000

<u>Design</u> – Trophies and cash awards will be given to the top three teams based on overall design and engineering concepts used in their written paper and oral presentation. First Place \$200 Second Place \$150 Third Place \$100

<u>**Performance**</u> – The top three teams in each category of the performance competition will receive trophies and cash awards.
